ANNOYANCE CALLS

Intentional annoyance of any person by use of the telephone is prohibited by law. In North Dakota, the maximum penalty for violation is 30 days imprisonment or a fine of \$500.00 or both.

THREATENING CALLS

It is against the law to use the telephone to threaten to inflict injury on any person, to any persons reputation, or to any property. The maximum penalty for violation is one year's imprisonment or a fine of \$1,000.00 or both.

FRAUD

It is unlawful in North Dakota to make, possess, sell, give or otherwise transfer any device that can be adapted to obtain free telecommunication services. The advertising of such devices and instructions for making or assembling the devices are also illegal. Fraudulent use of a calling card or telephone billing number in an attempt to obtain telecommunications service and avoid charges is prohibited by law. In North Dakota, the maximum penalty for these offenses is one year's imprisonment or a fine of \$1,000.00 or both.

LIGHTNING

During a lightning storm, use your phone at your own discretion because it could result in injury or death. Your telephone company assumes no liability for any accident or injury due to use of your phone during a lightning storm.

GENERAL INFORMATION

ALLOWANCE FOR FAILURE OF SERVICE

The Telephone Cooperative and/or Company DOES NOT GUARANTEE UNINTERRUPTED WORKING OF ITS LINES OR EQUIPMENT. In case service is interrupted other than by the negligence or willful act of the subscriber, an adjustment will, upon application by a subscriber, be made in the amount of the charges for such service, equipment, and facilities furnished as are rendered useless or inoperative. Any adjustment shall apply only to the period the interruption continues beyond twenty-four (24) hours after notice of the interruption is received by the Telephone Company. No other liability shall in any case attach to the Telephone Company. Request for adjustment on bill must be made within 45 days from period of trouble, interruption or billing question.

CONSUMER RIGHTS

If you have a problem the Telephone Company has not corrected to your satisfaction, you have the right to file a formal or informal complaint with the North Dakota Public Service Commission. Their address and phone number is: North Dakota Public Service Commission, State Capitol Building, Bismarck, N.D. 58505. 328-2400.

CONTRACT FOR SERVICE

A patron wishing service must sign an application for service which shall be self-renewing until written notice or default or regulation, by either party to the other is discontinued same.

DEFAULT OF PAYMENT OR OTHER VIOLATION OF REGULATIONS

Charges for exchange service and facilities are due in advance. Charges for toll and long distance service are due when the bill for such service is rendered. All bills are payable at the Telephone Company's business office. Failure to receive a bill does not exempt the subscriber from the prompt payment of his account. The subscriber is held responsible for all charges for exchange service and facilities furnished at his request and for all toll and long distance service furnished at his station or stations, including charges for toll messages received at his station or stations on which the charges have been reversed. In the event of default of payment of any sum due for either exchange or toll service or both, the use of foul or profane language, the impersonation of any other person with fraudulent intent, or any other violation of the Telephone Company's regulations, the Telephone Company may either suspend service or terminate the service without suspension.

INCORRECT DIRECTORY LISTINGS

The vast majority of all directory listings are correct. But, as with any job of this size, the possibility for errors does occur. If your listing in the directory is incorrect, it cannot be changed until the next edition of the directory is issued. In addition, the Telephone Company will assume no liability for damages caused to a subscriber because of such errors or omissions or be a party to controversies arising between subscribers or others as a result of listings published in its directories.

However, we can make sure the listing is correct in Directory Assistance records. In some cases, it is possible for calls to an incorrect number to be rerouted to the correct number.

Your service representative will be happy to help you.

SUBSCRIBERS RESPONSIBILITY OF TELEPHONE

Telephone instruments are for the use of signed subscribers, their families and employees only. The subscriber is requested not to permit any other person, firm or corporation the use of the same (especially to advertise same) without permission of the Telephone Cooperative and/or Company. All ordinary expense of maintenance and repair, unless otherwise specified in the Telephone Company's tariffs or in the contract for the use of the equipment, will be borne by the Telephone Company. In case of damage to or destruction of any of the said equipment due to negligence of the subscriber, the subscriber shall pay the cost of restoring the equipment to its original condition.

TARIFF, GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

A book containing the tariff, general rules and regulations covering the operation of the Cooperative and/or Company is open for inspection at the headquarters office and also on file with the Public Service Commission in the State Capitol at Bismarck.

GENERAL INFORMATION (CONT'D)

UNLAWFUL WIRETAPPING IS SUBJECT TO PROSECUTION

It is a crime under federal and state laws for any person to wiretap or otherwise intercept a telephone call, unless that person has first obtained the consent of one or both parties actually participating in the call. Properly authorized law enforcement offices can take part in interceptions without the consent of either party, when proceeding under court orders issued following the appropriate federal or state law. The penalty for illegal wiretapping can be imprisonment and/or a fine.

FRAUDULENT BILLING CAN LEAD TO PROSECUTION

It is illegal for a person to charge long distance calls to another's number or Calling Card without their permission. Persons placing such calls to avoid payment for service are subject to prosecution and if convicted are subject to imprisonment and/or a fine.

HARRASSMENT BY TELEPHONE

It is a crime under both state and federal laws for anyone to make obscene or harassing telephone calls. These laws have penalties of imprisonment and/or a fine.

If you do not want to talk with a person selling a product or service by telephone, just say "No thank you," and hang up. If you receive annoying, obscene or threatening calls, follow these suggestions:

- 1. Hang up at the first obscene word or if the caller doesn't say anything the second time you say hello.
- 2. Give no information such as your name and address until the caller has been identified.
- 3. Advise your children to give no information to strangers. If you're not home, they should say, "Mother/Father can't come to the phone right now."
- 4. If calls persist call your Business Office or your Police Department.

TELEPHONE EQUIPMENT

Moving Company Telephone Equipment

Telephone equipment on the premises of subscribers shall not be moved from one location to another except by a representative of the Telephone Company. For any changes in location of telephone equipment, or wiring, the subscriber shall be required to pay the established charge for making such change in location.

Customer Provided Telephone Equipment

Customers who provide their own telephone equipment are eligible for credit on extension charges or the basic monthly rate. However, Federal Communications Commission rules require that these customers must:

- 1. Before connecting the equipment, notify the telephone business office of which line connection will be made upon, plus the registration number and the ringer equivalence number that appear on the equipment. Equipment which has been legally connected to the network and equipment of the same type may be connected without a registration number until July 1, 1979. The manufacturer or retailer should be able to provide this information. If not, call your local telephone business office for assistance.
- 2. Connect the registered equipment through a standard jack provided by the Telephone Company.
- 3. Follow the installation, operation, maintenance and repair procedures specified by the manufacturer. Customers must remove the equipment from use if it is defective or if the Telephone Company notifies them it is causing a hazard to the network. Customers will be responsible for making arrangements and paying for repairing and replacing their own telephone equipment. The Telephone Company is not required to repair customer-provided equipment. Our Repair Service will conduct tests to determine the location of the trouble. If a repair visit is required and the service difficulty is caused by your equipment, you will be charged for the visit.

Home Wiring Options

The Telephone Company will wire your home. If you are building a new home or remodeling your home, we can install telephone wires before the walls are put up. We can also install additional phone extensions. Call a Service Representative for more information about this service and what charges apply. If you prefer, you can hire a phone contractor to do this work or you may do-it-yourself.

You can save money by dialing your calls direct without involving an operator. Long Distance Carriers usually offer lower rates on dial-direct calls.

Call when rates are lower

Some Long Distance Carriers offer lower rates on weeknights and weekends.

Operator handled calls cost more

Collect, calling card and coin phone calls may require the services of an operator. So do requests for time and charges and calls charged to another number. These operator-assisted calls cost more than dial-direct calls.

Person-to-person calls cost the most

Calling person-to-person can cost nearly twice as much as other operator-assisted calls. And many times more than the lowest dial-direct rate!

Take advantage of holiday rates

Some Long Distance Carriers offer lower rates on holidays.

Schedule your calls

If you call someone frequently, try to arrange a specific time when he or she will be there to take your call. That way you can dial direct and save!

Plan your conversation

Whether it's business or personal, jot down the things you want to talk about, the questions you want to ask. You'll save calling time - and you won't forget something you wanted to say.

Don't pay for wrong numbers

If you reach a wrong number, we don't want you to pay for it. Let the operator know right away so that you won't be charged for it. If you call from a coin phone, we'll mail you a refund.

Let it ring

When you make a call, give your party time to answer - at least 10 rings - before you hang up. This could save you having to make a second call later.

Bill problems

It's always a good idea to check your phone bill before you pay it. If you have a question about your bill, call a service representative in the business office.

Bad connection

If you get a poor connection or are cut off on a Long Distance call, both parties should hang up. Whoever placed the call should tell the operator about the bad connection so that the operator can re-establish the call for you and adjust the charge so you aren't charged for the interrupted time.

Use area codes

Be sure to use the correct area code when dialing outside your own area code. You will avoid reaching a wrong number. Area codes for many cities are listed on page 24.

Vacation rates

If you are going away for a month or more, you may save money by temporarily suspending your home or business telephone service. The suspended service rate is lower than most regular rates, and you can have your calls transferred to another number.

One trip

When you move, you can save money on connection charges if you have all your service options (items such as extensions and Push Button service) installed at the same time. Then the installer won't have to make a second trip to your home, and you won't have to pay a second charge.

Take your phone book with you when you move

It'll save you lots of time when you want to call back to friends or business associates you left behind - you'll already have their numbers and won't have to waste valuable time calling for Long Distance Directory Assistance.

Coin phone refunds

If one of our coin phones collects your money and doesn't complete your call, jot down the number and report it to us. Just dial "0" (operator) from another phone and we will mail you your refund and repair the phone that's out of order.

LONG DISTANCE CALLING TYPES OF CALLS

THERE ARE THREE BASIC KINDS OF LONG DISTANCE CALLS:

- 1. <u>Customer Dialed, Station-to-Station Call</u> is the least expensive type of call. If the customer dials the call direct without "OPERATOR'S" assistance, the customer is charged the lowest rate.
- 2. Operator-assisted Station-to-Station Calls require "OPERATOR" assistance for completion. The customer will talk with anyone who answers, but needs an "OPERATOR'S" aid to reach the number or for other reasons. Examples of such calls are coin, collect calls; calls billed to third number; code billing (special billing numbers, guest, time and charges and sequence calls.)
- 3. <u>Person-to-Person Call</u>, the most expensive type of calls for those occasions when the customer wishes to speak directly to a particular person, telephone, department or office reached through a customer's switchboard (PBX).

Station-To-Station Calls

Call station-to-station if you wish to talk with anyone who answers. Rates for calls that you dial yourself are lower than for calls dialed by the operator. Charging begins when the called telephone is answered.

Person-To-Person

Call person-to-person when you wish to talk to a particular person or extension number. Tell the "OPERATOR" you wish to make a "person-to-person" call. Rates are higher than station-to-station and also apply when you talk to an alternate person or extension. Charging starts when conversation begins.

Conference

You can talk with several people in different places at the same time. Tell the "OPERATOR" you wish to make a "conference" call. A special charge will be made for this type of call.

Problems With Calls

If you reach a wrong number, have a poor connection, or are disconnected, hang up and dial your local telephone company right away. Explain what happened so they can arrange for the proper credit.

Collect

You can call "collect" if the person or firm you are calling agrees to pay the charge. If you want to make a "collect" call, please be sure to tell the "OPERATOR" when you place the call.

Coin Calls

From coin phones, see the instruction card on or near the phone, or dial "OPERATOR".

Calling Card

Customers who have Calling Cards may place calls and charge them to their calling card numbers. If placed from a rotary dial telephone, these calls require "OPERATOR" assistance to record the calling card number. If placed from a push-button dial telephone, please use the instructions provided on your calling card. Calling card calls may be either station-to-station or person-to-person calls. Customers may apply for a calling card by calling their telephone company business office.

Bill To The Third

Customers may place calls and transfer the charge to another telephone. This service requires "OPERATOR" assistance. The call may be either station-to-station or person-to-person.

Wide Area Telecommunications Service (Inward WATS)

Station-to-Station long distance calls may be made without charge to you, to those customers who have Wide Area Telecommunications Service. They offer this service to their customers calling from specific locations. Dial "your access number" plus Area Code "800" plus the special numbers of customers having this service.

Mobile And Marine Calls

You can make local and long distance calls to automobiles, trucks, aircraft, boats and ships which have phones. Calls can be completed by dialing direct or calling the Operator. For information on other communications companies look in the Yellow Pages, under the heading of "Paging and Signaling -- Equipment."



Dial 411.

If You Reach a Wrong Number

Dial "Operator" right away and explain. You will not be charged.

Time and Charges

Customers, when placing calls, may request from the "Operator" the amount of time and charge for the call. This service requires "Operator" assistance. The call may be either Station-to-Station or Person-to-Person.

Overseas (Dial "Operator")

You can call practically any telephone in the world from your phone. Tell the Operator you want to place an "Overseas" Call and give her the name of the country that you are calling. DDD and O + dialing available to some exchanges. See 1st page of your Alphabetical Section.

To Reach Inward WATS Directory Assistance

Dial "1", then Area Code "800", then 555-1212 to obtain numbers of those customers who offer incoming long distance calls without charge to persons calling from specific locations. There is no long distance charge to you.

Other Special Calls (Dial "Operator")

Calling Card, Conference, Zenith, Mobile or other calls requiring special handling should be placed with the Operator.

To Obtain Rate to Any Place

Call "Long Distance" If you want to know the charge on a call at the close of your conversation, notify the Long Distance Operator BEFORE YOU PLACE THE CALL.

WHAT IS RELAY SERVICE?

Hearing persons and businesses who wish to talk with persons who are deaf, hard-of-hearing or have a speech impairment may use the telecommunications relay service to call them. Relay Service also provides full telephone accessibility to people who are deaf, hard-of-hearing, or speech impaired.

Specially trained operators confidentially complete relay calls and stay on the line to relay conversations electronically over text telephone (TTY) or verbally between the callers. If you place a call and hear a series of high-pitched sounds, it may be a TTY. You can call Relay North Dakota and give the operator the phone number to complete your call. There is no additional charge to users for using relay service (although long distance charges apply for long distance calls).

Information Technology Department contracted with Sprint to provide telephone relay service in North Dakota. This service, known as Relay North Dakota, is available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, with no restrictions on the number of calls placed or on their length. This valuable communications tool gives all individuals who are deaf, hard-of-hearing or speech impaired the opportunity to make personal and business calls just like any other telephone user. It also gives hearing persons the ability to telephone persons who are deaf, hard-of- hearing or speech impaired. Both TTY and voice users may initiate calls through Relay North Dakota.

SERVICES SUPPORTED BY SURCHARGE

A few cents per telephone bill surcharge makes North Dakota Relay services possible for the citizens of North Dakota. Sprint is the provider of the relay services for North Dakota.

CONFIDENTIALITY

Calls handled by Relay North Dakota are strictly confidential. All calls will be kept private, and no records of any conversation will be kept. Operators will not share information regarding the contents of any relay call.

EQUIPMENT DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM

CapTel ® - a free captioned phone service.

CapTel, short for captioned telephone, users place calls in the same way when dialing with a standard telephone. Utilizing voice

recognition technology that displays verbatim captions of the conversation on screen of a telephone or computer screen; the CapTel user can hear and read what the other person is saying.

How to apply for specialized telephone equipment The North Dakota Telecommunications Equipment Distribution Service (TEDS) is a program that provides free equipment for North Dakota residents with qualifying disabilities that interfere with the use of the telephone.

Individuals who are experiencing difficulty using their current telephone equipment are encouraged to apply to receive assisted equipment through the TEDS.

STANDARD TELEPHONE (VOICE) USERS

If you want to make a call, dial 711 or 1-800-366-6889. Relay North Dakota will answer with the operator's individual ID number, and ask, "May I have the number you are calling please?" (If you dial 711 and hear tones, stay on the line and an operator will answer shortly.) Give the operator the area code and telephone number you wish to call and any further instructions. The operator will relay exactly what the TTY user is typing. The operator will relay what you say back to the TTY user. (Be sure to talk directly to the person you called, avoid saying "tell him" or "tell her," and say "Go Ahead" at the end of each response.) Whenever you receive a call from Relay North Dakota, the operator will ask you if you are familiar with the service. If not, a brief explanation of the relay service will be given.

The call will then proceed as a direct conversation between you and the other party. Speak directly to the party you are calling as if the operator were absent.

TTY USERS

Dial 711 or 1-800-366-6888. Relay North Dakota will answer with the operator's individual ID number, "F" or "M" (for CA gender) and "NUMBER CALLING PLS GA." (GA means, "go ahead.") Type the area code and telephone number you wish to call and then type "GA." The operator will dial the number and relay the conversation to and from your TTY. Type in "GA" at the end of each message.

VOICE CARRY OVER (VCO) USERS

VCO allows deaf or hard-of-hearing relay users who prefer to use their own voice to speak directly to the party they are calling. The operator will type the voice response so the caller does not miss anything. Inform the operator you want to use VCO by typing "VCO PLS GA."

EMERGENCY/DIRECTORY ASSISTANCE

In case of an emergency, TTY users should call 911. All 911 centers in North Dakota are required to be TTY-equipped. Relay North Dakota will relay directory assistance calls between TTY users and the directory assistance operator. Once the caller makes the request, the relay operator will connect to the directory assistance operator. After obtaining the number, the caller may choose to place the call through Relay North Dakota or dial it directly.

HOME TELEPHONE ASSISTANCE

Lifeline is a federal program that offers a discount to qualified customers on their monthly telephone or internet service.

Home Telephone or Broadband Assistance

Lifeline provides up to a \$9.25 discount on your monthly bill for home telephone or broadband service.

Do you qualify for Lifeline assistance?

To be eligible for Lifeline, you must be enrolled in a qualifying program. Qualifying programs include: Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Medicaid, Supplemental Security Income (SSI), Federal Public Housing Assistance (FPHA), Veterans Pension and Survivors Benefit if your income is 135% or less than the federal poverty guidelines.

Apply Online:

You can apply online by going to CheckLifeline.org and creating an account. Once you have filled out the information, you will find out if you qualify for Lifeline assistance. You will need the following information to apply online:

Full legal name
Date of birth
Last 4 digits of your SSN
Address

Apply by Mail:

You can also send an application by mail. You will mail in your finished Lifeline Application (English or Spanish) Household Worksheet, and copies of your proof of eligibility to the Lifeline Support Center. USAV will contact you by mail to let you know if you qualify for Lifeline. The Lifeline Support Center's mailing address is:

If you receive an error message, please contact the National Lifeline program at 1-800-234-9473 for additional help.

The Lifeline program is administered by the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC).

USAC is responsible for data collection and maintenance, support calculation, and disbursement for the program. Once on the Lifeline program, you will be contacted by USAC annually to recertify. If you no longer meet the eligibility guidelines above, you will no longer qualify for Lifeline and must inform BEK of your ineligibility by calling 701-475-2361 or toll free at 1-888-475-2361.

CALLING FEATURES

3-WAY CALLING

Allows the subscriber to add a third party to an existing call without operator assistance.

"ANONYMOUS" CALL REJECTION

Allows the subscriber to reject all calls that are Caller ID Blocked by a caller. The caller will be routed to a recorded message that states "We're sorry the party you are calling does not wish to talk to callers who block their numbers, if you wish to reach this party, please hang up and place your call again without blocking your number." This is done by dialing *82.

CALL FORWARDING - BUSY LINE

Redirects your telephone calls to another telephone number only when your telephone line is busy.

CALL FORWARDING - DON'T ANSWER

Redirects your telephone calls to another telephone number if you do not answer your telephone call within a pre-specified number of seconds (default is 20 seconds). The number of telephone seconds before your call is forwarded is determined by you, the subscriber, but set by the telephone company.

CALL FORWARDING - REMOTE*

Allows you to activate call forwarding from a location other than your home phone. By using this feature, you may dial a special code to have your calls forwarded to another telephone number.

CALL FORWARDING - VARIABLE

Allows you to dial a special code to have your calls redirected from your telephone number to another telephone number. The subscriber will pay additional toll charges when forwarded to a long distance number.

CALL HOLD

Lets the subscriber place someone on hold when they want to initiate a second call.

CALL WAITING

A tone that tells you when another call is waiting to be answered. To answer the waiting call, the subscriber presses the flash button (if no flash button, the switch hook can be used). The subscriber can cancel the call waiting option before a telephone conversation for the duration of one call by dialing a special access code, if an uninterrupted call is necessary.

CALLER ID

When you receive a call, the telephone number calling you and the name associated with that number in the telephone company records will automatically appear on your phone or a Caller ID unit attached to your phone. If you choose to answer the call, the name and number remains on the screen until you or the caller hangs up.

CALLER ID BLOCKING

Enables the subscriber to control disclosure of their telephone number and name to a subscriber of Caller ID. Calls to 911 are not affected by Caller ID Blocking.

DISTINCTIVE RINGING

Allows up to three unique ringing patterns, which can determine for whom a call is intended. Great for fax machines.

DO NOT DISTURB*

Allows the subscriber to prevent calls from ringing at your telephone by diverting them to a tone or recorded announcement.

FIND ME*

Allows an incoming call to ring your phone number and up to six other phone numbers at the same time. Long distance charges may apply when Find Me calls are answered at a long distance number.

HOME INTERCOM (REVERTIVE CALL)*

Enables you to call another telephone connected to your telephone line.

LAST CALL RETURN

Tells you the telephone number of the most recent incoming call. If you want to call that number, simply press "1."

PRIORITY RINGING

Creates a priority ringing list of up to six numbers. When those parties call, you know it by a special ring! This affects regular ringing and call waiting tones.

REPEAT DIALING

Redials the last outgoing telephone number you dialed. If busy, it will continue dialing for 30 minutes. You may still make and receive other calls.

SELECTIVE CALL ACCEPTANCE*

Uses a list function to store up to 6 directory numbers from which you receive calls. An incoming call from a directory number that is not on your list is routed to an announcement stating that the called party does not wish to receive the call.

SELECTIVE CALL FORWARDING*

Allows you to ensure that selected calls reach you when you are away from your home or office. Incoming calls from up to six directory numbers can be forwarded to another location. Calls from directory numbers that are not on the list can be picked up at your home or office. If you forward your calls to a distant telephone where long distance charge applies, you will be billed the charges.

CALLING FEATURES (CONT'D)

SELECTIVE CALL REJECTION*

Enables the subscriber to block the last incoming call and/or calls for a maximum of ten (10) specified telephone numbers. Callers whose numbers are blocked are directed to a recorded announcement.

SPEED CALL-8

Allows the subscriber to create a list of up to eight (8) emergency or frequently dialed numbers which the subscriber can call by dialing a one-digit code. The one-digit code can be any number from 2 to 9.

TOLL RESTRICTION*

Prohibits any toll (e.g. long distance) calls from being made from or charged to the subscriber's phone number.

TOLL RESTRICTION WITH PIN*

Allows a subscriber to make a long distance call after having put Toll Restriction on their line. To bypass the Toll Restriction, the subscriber must dial the number followed by a Personal Identification Number (PIN)

WARM LINE*

Allows a predetermined telephone number to be automatically dialed from The subscriber's telephone line when that subscriber takes the telephone off the hook and does not dial any digits within 15 seconds. The predetermined number must be entered by the telephone company, the subscriber cannot change this information.

Voice Mail

Provides a 24 hour voice mail answering and message storage system. Messages may be retrieved from any touch-tone telephone.

Complaints must be filed within 180 days after the alleged discrimination. Confidentiality will be maintained to the extent possible.

A *Preferred Carrier Freeze* is a way of preventing your long distance services from being switched without your permission (slamming). Slamming is a process in which one long distance carrier changes your current long distance services without your authorization. Contact your local telephone company for more information on this service.

PAY PER CALL SERVICE INFORMATION

"900" Numbers - FTC Rule Helps Consumers

Before making a 900 number call, you need to know how much the call will cost, what you will get for your money, and what will happen if you have a billing dispute

The Federal Trade Commission's <u>900 Number Rule</u> took the guesswork out of these calls by requiring certain information in ads and preambles for 900 number services. You also have protections under the Federal Communication Commission's own 900 Number Rule that governs the practices of telephone companies.

900 NUMBER ADS

All print, radio, and television advertisements for 900 number services must include:

- the total cost of the call if there's a flat fee;
- the per-minute rate if the call is charged by the minute, as well as any minimum charge. If the length of the program is known in advance, the ad also must state the total cost of the complete program:
- the range of fees if there are different rates for different options. The ad also must state the initial cost of the call and any minimum charges;
- · the cost of any other 900 number to which you may be transferred; and
- any other fees the service might charge.

This information can't be hidden in small print: The cost of the call must be next to the 900 number and printed in a size that's at least half the size of the 900 number. In a television ad, an audio cost disclosure must also be made.

WHAT YOU SHOULD HEAR FIRST

When you dial a 900 number that costs more that \$2, you should hear an introductory message or "preamble." You can't be charged for this message. It must briefly describe the service, the name of the company providing the service, and the cost of the call. It also must state that anyone under age 18 needs parental permission to complete the call. Once this information is provided, you must be given three seconds to hang up without incurring a charge.

EXCEPTIONS TO THE RULE

The 900 Number Rule does not apply if you have a pre-existing contractual agreement with an information service. Be very careful about entering such an arrangement. If you do, your calls to the service - and resulting bills - will not be subject to the Rule's requirements.

The Rule also excludes calls charged to a credit card. However, the bills for such calls would be covered by the dispute resolution procedures of the Fair Credit Billing Act.

BILLING ERRORS AND DISPUTES

The 900 Number Rule has procedures for resolving billing disputes. Always check your telephone bill for 900 number charges. For each 900 call, your statement should include the date, time, and, for services that have per-minute rates, the length of the call. These charges must

PAY PER CALL SERVICE INFORMATION (CONT'D)

appear separately from local and long distance charges. Your statement also must include a local or toll-free number for questions about your pay-per-call charges.

Under FCC regulations, the phone company cannot disconnect your regular local or long-distance service if you don't pay a 900 number charge. However, you could be blocked from making future calls to 900 numbers if you don't pay legitimate 900 number charges.

If you find an error on your bill, follow the instructions on your statement. They will tell you who to call or write to dispute the charge. In most cases, it will be your local or long-distance telephone company, but it could be the 900 number company or an independent firm that provides billing services for that company.

You must notify the company listed on your bill within 60 days from the date the first statement containing the error was sent. The company must acknowledge your notice in writing within 40 days unless it has resolved the dispute by that time. Within two billing cycles, but not longer that 90 days, the company must:

- · correct the billing error and notify you of the correction, or
- investigate the matter and either correct the error or explain the reason for not doing so.

A company cannot charge you to investigate or respond to a billing dispute. No one can try to collect the disputed charge from you - or report it to a credit bureau - until the company handling the dispute either has corrected the error or explained its reason for not doing so. Companies that don't comply with these rules lose their right to collect up to \$50 of each disputed charge.

However, even if the 900 number charge is removed from your bill, the service provider might pursue the charge some other way, such as through a collection agency. If so, you have additional rights under the Fair Debt Collection Practices Act.

SWEEPSTAKES AND FEDERAL PROGRAMS

The Rule also covers 900 number services that promote sweepstakes or offer information about government programs. For example, some services offer the chance to enter a sweepstakes and win a prize simply by dialing a 900 number and, in some cases, entering a code. The Rule requires ads for sweepstakes to state the odds of winning or how odds will be calculated.

In addition, the ad or preamble must tell you there's a free way to enter the sweepstakes, how to enter, or how to get that information. You shouldn't have to call - and incur a charge - to enter. This provision doesn't apply to contests where you have to demonstrate a skill, such as answer a question correctly.

Other 900 numbers provide information about federal programs even though they're not affiliated with a government agency. This could mislead some consumers. Under the Rule, the ad and preamble must state that such services are not authorized, endorsed, or approved by a federal agency.

The Rule essentially prohibits companies from promoting 900 numbers to young children. Some companies have promoted 900 numbers to children, encouraging them to pick up the phone to talk to a cartoon character. Under the FTC 900 Number Rule, companies are prohibited from advertising or offering pay-per-call services to children under age 12, unless the services are truly educational in nature.

If ads are directed to young people under age 18, they must state that parental permission is required to make the call. Preambles for all 900 number services must contain that statement.

TOLL-FREE NUMBERS

The Rule generally prohibits:

- using 800, 888, or other toll-free numbers for pay-per-call services, unless you have a pre-existing agreement with the company or you charge the call to a credit card;
- connecting you directly from an 800, 888, or other toll-free number to a 900 number; and
- a collect call back if you have dialed an 800, 888, or other toll-free number.

FCC RULES ON COLLECT CALLS

Under FCC regulations, pay-per-call services can't make collect calls to you if the charge would be more than - or in addition to - the regular long distance charge for the call. Services that don't impose this additional charge can call collect. However, you can't be charged for the call unless you have clearly indicated that you'll accept the charge.

TIPS FOR AVOIDING 900 NUMBER PROBLEMS

Scams involving 900 numbers are constantly changing. To help protect yourself:

- Deal only with reputable companies. Some companies or organizations sponsor 900 number services for opinion surveys, information, entertainment or other services. Before you call a 900 number, be sure you understand the cost of the call and the nature of the information or service you'll receive.
- Think twice before calling a 900 number for a "free" gift. Television ads, postcards and telemarketers may urge you to call a 900 number to get a "free" prize. But you pay for the so-called free gift by making the 900 number call. The provider of the service usually makes money on a per-minute basis, so there's an incentive to keep you on the line.
- Don't confuse 900 numbers with 800 or 888 numbers. You pay for a 900 number call. The company pays for most 800, 888, or other toll-free number calls.
- Talk with your children. Make sure they understand they shouldn't call 900 numbers without your permission. You can have the phone company block 900 number calls from your phone. The FCC requires local phone companies to make blocking available where technically feasible for a "reasonable" fee. However, any subscriber with a new number can request free blocking within 60 days after service begins.

Although the Commission cannot resolve individual problems for consumers, it can act against a company if it sees a pattern of possible law violations.



AREA CODES & TIME ZONES MAP





Simple tests can be done to determine whether to call your local telephone company or another company.

These tests may save you time and money.

Repair Service reporting numbers are on page 8 of this section.

BEFORE YOU CALL

- 1. Hang up all telephones. Make sure phone accessories answering or fax machines, computers, modems, security system, and telephone sets are working. To check, unplug the phone cord from the unit or the jack and check for damage. Leave everything unplugged for 5 minutes. Then try plugging in phone sets one at a time to see if the trouble still exists.
- 2. If all the phone accessories are working, go to your network interface box. (Outside, where the phone line enters the house.)
- **3.** Test to determine if the problem is inside or outside the house:
 - A. Take a working phone to the network interface box (single line phone only.)
 - B. Remove the modular plug from the test jack and insert the modular plug from your phone.

If the same problem occurs:


the problem may be in the phone lines. Call your local telephone company. If the problem is in the phone lines, they will repair the lines at no charge to you.


If the problem does not occur:

the problem is in your wiring. Call your local telephone company or another company to repair your inside wiring.

If the problem is in your telephone set:

follow the instructions on your warranty or contact your equipment retailer for repair or replacement.
